Company signs MoU with GJU, establishes faculty

AMMAN (Petra) — The German ordinal University Applied Sciences (GJU) on Tuesday signed a memorar dum of understanding (MoU) with the Talsi University Administration and which the company will establish a faculty at the GJU. The faculty would grant BA and MA degrees in administrative and financial sciences, IT and communications. Under the MoU, a higher consultation council will be formed grouping members from both institutions. The university will also have the right to open up a branch of the faculty in other Arab countries.
