Company signs MoU with GJU, establishes faculty



AMMAN (Petra) — The German Jordanian University of Applied Sciences (GJU) on Tuesday signed a memorandum of understanding (MoU) with the Talsi Abu Ghazaleh Company for University Administration, under which the company will establish a faculty at the GJU. The faculty would grant BA and MA degrees in administrative and financial sciences, IT and communications. Under the MoU, a higher consultation council will be formed grouping members from both institutions. The university will also have the right to open up a branch of the faculty in other Arab countries. The agreement was signed in the presence of Minister of Education and Minister of Higher Education and Scientific Research Khalid Fouqar.
