

UN readies for its biggest-ever gathering on

corporate citizenship

More than 700 business leaders and hundreds of top representatives from g and civil society are expected to attend the Global Compact Leaders Summ which will be the largest ever gathering convened by the United Nations on corporate citizenship.

Created by Mr. Ban's predecessor, Kofi Annan, in 1999, the Global Compact tries to advance 10 principles of good corporate citizenship and responsible areas as combating corruption, safeguarding the environment, ensuring soc building markets.
