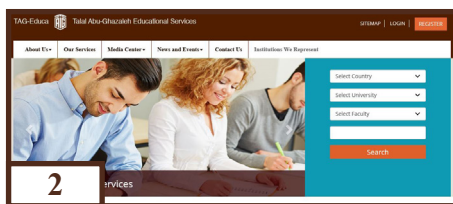

Moreover, the two parties conducted a visit to the Doha Clinic Hospital resulted in an agreement to audit Information Systems and suggest the best policies

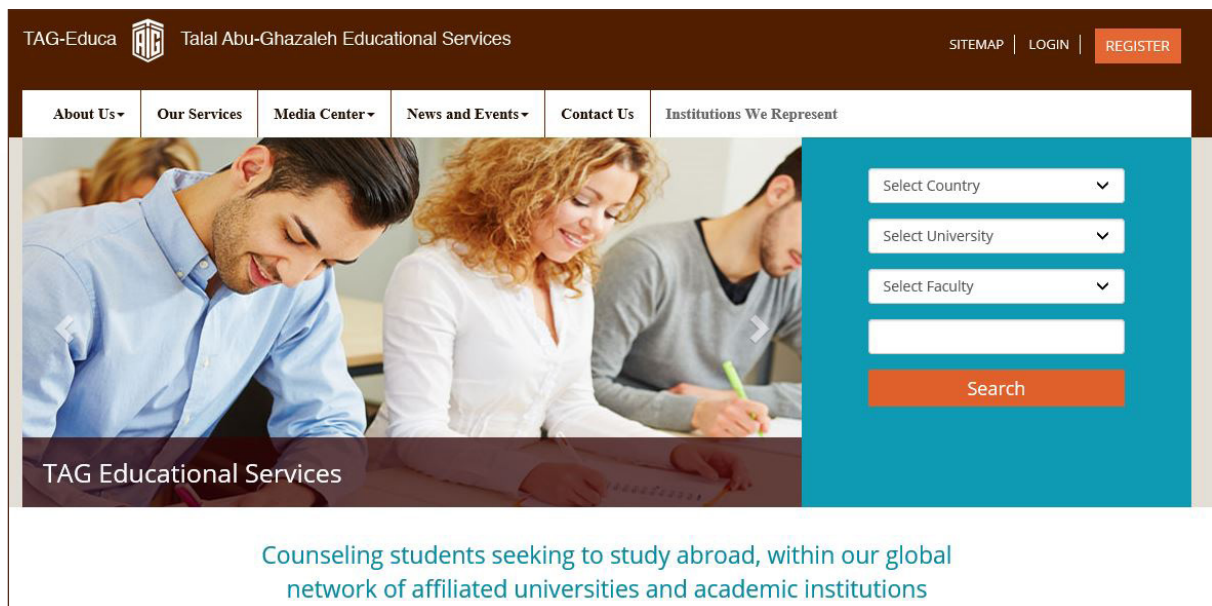
and procedures for development in addition to revisit the Hospital's website regarding security and design in addition to content.
