ICANN Launches \$10 Million Grant Program to Boost Global Internet Growth

ICANN, the organization overseeing the Domain Name System, has announced a \$10 million grant initiative to propel projects supporting "the growth of a single, open and globally interoperable Internet." The first application cycle for grants is set to open in March 2024.

As per the International Telecommunication Union (ITU), 5.3 billion people globally accessed the Internet in 2022, showcasing a 6.1% growth from the previous year. ICANN's Grant Program aims to bolster the inclusive and transparent development of stable and secure internet infrastructure solutions to support the Internet's identifier systems.

"With the rapid evolution of emerging technologies, businesses and security models, it is critical that the Internet's unique identifier systems continue to evolve," said Sally Costerton, Interim President and CEO, ICANN. "The ICANN Grant Program offers a new avenue to further those efforts by investing in projects that are committed to and support ICANN's vision of a single, open and globally interoperable Internet that fosters inclusion amongst a broad, global community of users."

ICANN is set to accept grant applications from March 25, 2024, to May 24, 2024. Following closure, applications will undergo checks for admissibility and eligibility. The Independent Application Assessment Panel will review and announce the grantees tentatively in January 2025.

TRADEMARKS

- Major change to the trademark registration process, where the e-filing system no longer allows selecting class headings upon filing trademark applications.
- Adoption of the 12th Edition of the NICE Classification.

South Sudan

Although the Intellectual Property Bill has not been passed into law, it became possible to reserve trademarks, where a third party will not be able to register a similar mark once the Bill becomes law.

Libya

The Trademark Office resumed its full activities after a suspension.

UAE

New procedures for trademark renewal allow trademark applications to be renewed • KSA without a legalized POA.



Publication of patents and industrial designs became in electronic format and through the official patent online platform of the Patent Office.



New patent and design regulations introducing new charges applicable to academic and SME entities, and allowing a grace period of 90 days for the submission of legal documents and Arabic translations following the filing of an application.

China

Release of the Revised Patent Examination **Guidelines and Implementing Regulations** of the Patent Law.

- Introduction of the "WIPO Publish" search system to search for patents granted by the GCCPO.
- GCCPO started accepting new filings (Paris Convention applications), and performing formality and substantive examination pertaining to Qatar

- KSA has officially joined the Patent Prosecution Highway (PPH) pilot program with the Intellectual Property Office of Singapore.
- SAIP has been appointed as an International Searching and Preliminary Examining Authority under the Patent Cooperation Treaty (PCT/ISA/IPEA).

ICANN to Hold APAC DNS Forum 2024 in Bali, Indonesia

The Internet Corporation for Assigned Names and Numbers (ICANN) announced plans for the Asia Pacific (APAC) Domain Name System (DNS) Forum 2024. Organized jointly by ICANN and Pengelola Nama Domain Internet Indonesia (PANDI), the APAC DNS Forum 2024 is scheduled to take place 23–24 July 2024 in Bali, Indonesia.

The APAC DNS Forum 2024 will convene regional DNS experts and the broader community to discuss the latest developments, opportunities, and challenges in the domain name marketplace. Topics may include the digital outlook for the APAC region, cybersecurity, and the future of the DNS and emerging technologies. To provide participants the flexibility to attend in person or remotely, the APAC DNS Forum 2024 will be held as a hybrid event.

Amendments to Egypt's Domain Name Registration Rules

CAIRO - The Egyptian Universities Network (EUN), the entity responsible for the administration of domain names in Egypt, announced some amendments to the rules for the registration and administration of .eg, which entered into force on January 1, 2024.

The new rules primarily introduced some arrangements in the domain name system, allowing to register the domain name in the name of corporate products and services, where there is no need to mention that name in the commercial register, on the condition that:

- 1. The applicant company submits its commercial register or tax card, provided that the name of the company is mentioned in the tax card.
- 2. The applicant company submits a letter proving its ownership of that domain.
- 3. The applicant company provides proof of the existence of the product or service, such as an advertising folder, a

picture of the product on the website, an advertising campaign, or any physical image in any way used to promote the product or service.

The Egyptian Universities Network affirmed that it has the right to suspend the domain that has been registered in the name of the product or service and used in bad faith for numerous reasons, such as to disrupt the competitor's business.

On the other hand, the Egyptian Universities Network will continue applying the 50% discount on the registration of new domains under (.eg) for the first year only, provided that the application is submitted for the first time for the required domain name, and that the domain is renewed the next year at no extra fees.




