UNRWA in Jordan and Abu-Ghazaleh discuss new cooperation programs to support Palestine Refugees



A new initiative launched by Talal Abu-Ghazaleh Global Digital Group

Amman - The Chairman and Founder of Talal Abu-Ghazaleh Global Group, His Excellency Dr. Talal Abu-Ghazaleh, during his visit to the offices of the United Nations Relief and Works Agency for Palestine Refugees (UNRWA) in Jordan, discussed ways to enhance joint cooperation in many important fields. was launched enabling Palestine Refugees to update their details and register online. This facilitates their access to the services available at the agency including, education, health, relief, social services, and microfinance, in addition to ensuring that they preserve their rights and the rights of their children as refugees from Palestine and in accordance with United Nations resolutions.

Mr. Becker pointed out that the “All for Palestine Association”, which was founded by Dr. Talal Abu-Ghazaleh, constituted a wonderful initiative to showcase the positive contributions to society of Palestinians around the world.

His Excellency Dr. Abu-Ghazaleh affirmed his support for UNRWA’s humanitarian efforts in serving Palestine refugees, noting that he personally graduated from university with a scholarship from UNRWA, for which he always feels grateful.

Dr. Abu-Ghazaleh outlined the support provided by Talal Abu-Ghazaleh Global Group to Palestine refugees, including the one million master’s scholarship offered by Talal Abu-Ghazaleh Global Digital University in the specialties of (artificial intelligence, information technology, digital marketing, intellectual property, and supply chain management), with the objective to be provided to more than one million Palestine refugees.

His Excellency Abu Ghazaleh, pointed out that the “All for Palestine Association” is a unique and unparalleled association, as it is neither for profit nor political, and its establishment came with the aim of documenting Palestinian creativity and achievements around the world, noting that the number of registered people on the All for Palestine website is (10,000) around the world. While the number of registered Palestinian inventors exceeded (5000).

The attendees stressed cooperation in supporting UNRWA’s mission in documenting Palestine refugee data and UNRWA’s vital role in that.

The meeting witnessed praise for the services provided by Abu-Ghazaleh through the positions he held at the United Nations.

The meeting, hosted by UNRWA, was attended by experts and specialists from both sides in the fields of education, relief, social services, documentation, registration and media staff.

‘Abu-Ghazaleh for Technology’ Wins Membership of Jordan Airport Free Zone’s Golden List

AMMAN – Talal Abu-Ghazaleh for Technology (TAGTech), a member of Talal Abu-Ghazaleh Global (TAG.Global), has won the Membership of the 2023 Golden List of Queen Alia International Airport Free Zone. Abu-Ghazaleh: Cybersecurity is one of the key challenges threatening the future of humanity

BEIRUT - HE Dr. Talal Abu-Ghazaleh, founder and chairman of Talal Abu-Ghazaleh Global (TAG Global), has stressed that cybersecurity is considered one of the key important issues that threaten the future of humanity, due to its challenges that compel everyone to protect national security. Dr. Abu-Ghazaleh's remarks came during his participation as a keynote speaker at the Cybersecurity Conference organized by the Adnan Kassar School of Business at the Lebanese American University (LAU) in cooperation with BMB Smart, under the title "Smart Shield: Protecting Information in the Digital Age".

In his speech, Dr. Abu-Ghazaleh referred to the unprecedented changes and development of the Internet since he assumed his role in the United Nations ICT Task Force in 2000; stating that 'cybersecurity is a standalone science that needs to permanently keep pace with technology advancements to safeguard data and information in all its forms from any theft, deletion, or change. He also referred to the significance of the Conference, which



serves as an important tool for keeping abreast with the most recent advancements in cybersecurity science. In addition, Dr. Abu-Ghazaleh expressed his thanks to Lebanon, noting it is one of the countries that are distinguished by supporting creativity regardless of any disagreements, political disputes, or other conditions.

For his part, LAU President, Dr. Michel Mawad, said that the theme of the Conference constitutes one of the most important issues of our era since it interferes with human existence in an unprecedented way, reviewing the concept of protection for individuals and the groups. "The University deals with information systems at various levels, including medical, academic, financial, and human resources. Cybersecurity is important to safeguard data and secure systems against any threats during their operations," he said. For his

part, Lebanon's Minister of Telecommunications, HE Mr. Johnny Korm, stated that economic and security infrastructure may be jeopardized in the digital age that we live in, which exceeds responsibility beyond traditional borders and known defenses. Additionally, he reaffirmed that cybersecurity is a matter of national security that has become a basic need that requires cooperation and partnership between the public and the private sectors in order to combine innovation with public policies to ensure security and effective performance.

It is worth mentioning that the Conference was held in the presence of Head of the Cybercrime Division, Colonel Patrick Obeid, heads and managers of companies and institutions specialized in the Internet and cybersecurity, and a host of experts in the field from Lebanon, Arab and foreign countries.
