'Abu-Ghazaleh Global' and Lebanese University Sign Agreement to Establish the First Technological Devices Factory in Lebanon



BEIRUT – Talal Abu-Ghazaleh Global (TAG.Global) has signed an agreement with the Lebanese University to establish the first-of-it's-kind factory in Lebanon for manufacturing technological devices at the University's branch in Al Fanar area. The agreement was signed in the presence of HE Dr. Talal Abu-Ghazaleh, founder and chairman of TAG.Global, but the signing ceremony was attended by a large number of ministers, MPs, and officials in Lebanon, including Minister of Education and Higher Education, HE Dr. Abbas Halabi, Minister of Industry, HE Mr. George Boujikian, Minister of Youth and Sports, HE Dr. George Kallass, Minister of Labor, HE Mr. Moustafa Bayram, Former Minister of Industry, HE Mr. Imad Hoballah. The press and media representatives were also there to cover the event..

The agreement, signed by the University President, Prof. Bassam Badran, and Mr. Burhan Al Ashkar, representative of HE Dr. Talal Abu-Ghazaleh for Culture and Media in Lebanon, aims to manufacture, assemble and produce technological devices, such as smartphones, tablets, and laptops with the motto (Made in Lebanon); a step that would remarkably provide job and training opportunities for the Lebanese students and people.

In this regard, Minister Halabi said: "Today is considered a milestone achievement in the University's journey to be designated as the Productive University, by establishing Talal Abu-Ghazaleh for Technology (TAGTech) factory that manufactures and produces devices under the label (Made in Lebanon), numerous job and technical training opportunities will be created for university students and others."

For his part Dr. Abu-Ghazaleh expressed his pride in the partnership with the University, noting that it is a true partnership where responsibilities and outcomes are equally shared. He further stressed that "Through this partnership, we have successfully established the TAGTech factory in the University's headquarters, where commitments will be put into action, not just promises."

Dr. Abu-Ghazaleh also pointed out that the factory would create training opportunities for the University students in the field of technology industry, as it would contribute to increasing the Lebanese Gross National Product (GNP).

Minister Boujikian also affirmed that the Ministry would issue an industrial certificate under the name of the Lebanese University to support this joint project between the University and TAGTech, pointing out that establishing such a factory is the start of a promising and important sector that Lebanon needs during these challenging circumstances.

In his key remarks, University President Prof. Badran, confirmed, that the agreement will contribute to generating learning, training, and employment opportunities for its students. This will enable students to become members of its faculties and research cadres in the faculties of engineering, science, management, and the Institute of Technology. In addition, they may benefit from the emerging opportunities of manufacturing, production, development, programming, marketing, and management in the factory.

The Journal of Management, Financial and Banking Studies Hosts Dr. Abu-Ghazaleh in an Extensive Interview on Digital Transformation

AMMAN - The Journal of Management, Financial and Banking Studies, has hosted HE Dr. Talal Abu-Ghazaleh, founder and chairman of Talal Abu-Ghazaleh Global (TAG. Global) for an interview in its recently published 117 edition.

During the meeting, several topics were thoroughly discussed such as Artificial Intelligence (AI) and concerns about its impact on employment, as well as its future at the global and Arab region levels. That is in addition to the economic crisis the world is currently experiencing, among others.

At the beginning of the interview, Dr. Abu-Ghazaleh talked about his life journey as a Palestinian refugee in Lebanon and how he started in Kuwait as an employee who, through determination and dedication, subsequently succeeded in establishing such a prominent Organization that presently operates through more than 100 offices all over the world.He further pointed out that he has dedicated to dedicate the next chapter of his life to raising awareness on the importance of digital transformation. He said that TAG.Global plays an effective role in implementing the



digital transformation project in the Arab world, starting from the Arab countries where technology is most needed like Lebanon, Syria, and Libya. Dr. Abu-Ghazaleh emphasized that the Arab countries still have the ability and the potential to embrace technology and get going, pointing out that the first world's renaissance was led by the Arab world, and despite what is happening now, it still is qualified and capable of leading the world again.

He further gave several guidelines to developing countries to catch up with the train economic development, starting with the importance developing educational, technical, and professional training programs, moving towards becoming productive countries, pursuing a national plan to adopt advanced technologies and industries, in addition to becoming selfsufficient countries particularly with respect to food. Concerning the economic crisis, numerous countries are currently experiencing, which Dr. Abu-Ghazaleh had previously predicted that it may lead to a third World War, he called on the Arab countries to implement the international agreements with the World Trade Organization (WTO) to ensure an attractive environment for investment, with the need to secure selfsufficiency and security.

AMMAN – HE Dr. Talal Abu-Ghazaleh, founder and chairman of Talal Abu-Ghazaleh Global (TAG.Global), has participated as keynote speaker and Guest of Honor at the 15th International Conference for Human Resources Experts, held at the University of Jordan (UJ).

The Conference convened under the patronage of Former Minister of Labor, HE Dr. Maen Al Qatamin, and UJ President, Prof. Nathir Obeidat, under the theme: 'The Future of HR Management in Light of Digital Transformation and Artificial Intelligence'. It was organized by the Wisdom Makers for Governance and Sustainable Development Institute.

For his part, Dr. Al Qatamin stated that HR Management is one of the most important professions in any enterprise, noting that the mission of HRM staff become even harder in the era of digital transformation and Al. He referred to the importance of the corporate's organizational structure and culture in helping achieve the company's goals.

He added that the many challenges and responsibilities HR faces necessitate employing technology in the workplace and in human resources management.

Meanwhile, Wisdom Makers CEO, Dr. Mohammad Khalifa, said that human resources management is the cornerstone of managing institutions and organizations towards achieving a sustainable competitive advantage. He pointed out that in light of the knowledge development, the trend now is towards revamping tools, procedures, and practices that are applied in all institutions, regardless of their scale and whether they are public, private, profit, or non-profit organizations.

During the Conference, participants discussed the reality of the human resources field in the Arab region; the trends, the paths, and the development towards the future of qualification and education in the knowledge society, in the presence of a number of HR experts and specialists, as well as representatives from various local, national and private sector institutions.

At the end of the conference, Dr. Abu-Ghazaleh was awarded with the Shield of HR Experts Conference, while Mr. Ala'a Yaseen, TAG.Global Human Resource Executive Director, was presented with the HR Excellence Award.




