Microsoft Partners with Novel on Linux

In a surprise announcement, Microsoft and Novell announced a partnership that will forever change the Linux landscape.

The two key components of the agreement revolve around interoperability and patents. The deal is not with Linux in general but specifically with Novell's SUSE Linux offerings.

The Microsoft Novell agreements are set to be in place until at least 2012 and involves joint work on the use of patent and interoperability. As part of the deal, Microsoft will also be buying as many as 70,000 units of Novell's SUSE Linux enterprise server.

Novell and Microsoft will also create a joint research facility that focuses on interoperability between Linux and Windows. The key elements of interoperability covered by the agreement are virtualization, virtualization management, and inter-office suite (Office to OpenOffice) interoperability.

The two partners will also now collaborate on sales and marketing for both companies' interoperable solutions.
