





Born on April 22nd 1938, HE Dr. Abu-Ghazaleh is the Founder and Chairman of TAG-Org. He also founded the Talal Abu-Ghazaleh Graduate School of Business (TAG-SB), which is the first school of its kind in the Arab world. TAG-SB represents a partnership between the private and public sectors and provides educational opportunities in line with the highest international standards.

The Talal Abu-Ghazaleh University College of Business (TAG-UCB) was established in Bahrain in 2012 with the aim of developing future business leaders who can compete and succeed in a world of expanding knowledge and complex and challenging economic forces.

Meanwhile, the Talal Abu-Ghazaleh Digital University (TAG-DU) MBA program provides a unique opportunity to students to complete a set of required MOOC (Massive Open Online Courses) courses and to obtain an MBA (Master of Business Administration) degree from the Talal Abu-Ghazaleh Digital University, thereby opening new doors to many students around the world.

ICTDAR – Talal Abu Ghazaleh for Small and Medium Enterprises (ICTDAR – TAG SMEs)

1. ICTDAR - TAG SMEs Program in Manama, Bahrain

The Government of Bahrain, through the Capital Mall, has supported traditional businesses in the Kingdom and has supported individual proprietors to help them sustain their livelihood. The Government's strategy is to invest in projects that have a promising future and would add value to the people and the Kingdom.

As part of the strategy, TAG-Org was appointed to conduct an exercise to establish the potential of the individuals and their business concepts utilizing the ICTDAR-TAG SME program; as a result, TAG-Org conducted three training courses for 124 entrepreneurs.

2. ICTDAR - TAG SMEs Program in Dubai, The UAE

Al Fujeirah College in RAS Al Khaimah believes in the potential of its students and their ability to start their own businesses, they have selected TAG-Org to offer them a course in entrepreneurship using the ICTDAR – TAG SME Program.

3. ICTDAR - TAG SMEs Program in Erbil, Iraq

ICTDAR – TAG SME Program conducted a course for 42 trainees in cooperation with the International Organization for Migration in Erbil.

4. ICTDAR - TAG SMEs Program in Amman, Jordan

The Small and Micro Enterprise Promotion Service (SMEPS) in Yemen agreed with TAG-Org to train a number of entrepreneurs on how to manage and excel in their own businesses.

TAG-Confucius Institute (TAG-CI)

TAG-Confucius Institute (TAG-CI) was established in September 2008 based on a cooperation agreement between TAG-Org and Confucius Institute Headquarters in Hanban, China, with Shenyang Normal University as the partner University. TAG-CI aims to promote Chinese language teaching and cultural exchange between China and Jordan.

TAG-CI is the first official Chinese language teaching center and the first Chinese Proficiency Test (Hanyu Shuiping Kaoshi, HSK) center in Jordan, which provides Chinese language courses for adults and children and organizes HSK tests in addition to many educational and cultural events.

TAG-CI and Shenyang Normal University (SNU)

10th Anniversary of Confucius Institute

September 24th, 2014 witnessed the 10th anniversary of Confucius Institute. TAG-CI conducted a series of events to celebrate the grand occasion including art performances presented by the art troupe form SNU.

"Chinese Bridge" and "The Great Wall-Petro Cup" Chinese Proficiency Competition

The "Chinese Bridge" Chinese Proficiency Competition and "The Great Wall-Petro Cup" Chinese Proficiency Competition is an annually-held great event. The "Chinese Bridge" Chinese Proficiency Competition is sponsored by the CI Headquarters in Hanban, China and hosted by the Chinese Embassy in Jordan. Its aim is to arouse the enthusiasm and interest of youth of other countries in learning Chinese language and understanding Chinese culture. In the competition, the students deliver a speech in Chinese, answer Chinese culture-related questions and demonstrate their talents. The competition also provides a stage for youth of other countries to display their Chinese proficiency and creates a platform of mutual study and exchange for students.

Scholarships

Since the establishment of TAG-CI, TAG-CI has been recommending qualified students to CI Headquarters for scholarships. As of 2016, 89 students have been awarded Confucius Institute scholarships to study at SNU. In addition, TAG-CI has helped one student to successfully receive a scholarship from the Chinese government. He will be reading for his master's degree in Qingdao University in China in September 2016.

Self-funded Study at SNU

TAG-CI has helped five students to be admitted to SNU in 2016. Three of whom will major in Chinese language and culture, one will major in Chinese-English translation and the fifth will major in software engineering.

Summer Camp in China 2015

From July 22nd to August 5th, 2015, the Confucius Institute Headquarters in Hanban, China, Shenyang Normal University and TAG-Confucius Institute jointly organized a summer camp in China. There were seventeen participants in the summer camp which consisted of Chinese language study, Chinese cultural knowledge study as well as cultural experiences such as Chinese geography, history, Peking opera, taiji boxing, calligraphy, tea ceremony and tea tasting, traditional handcraft, Chinese foods as well as an "Arabic night" party, and more. In addition, Shenyang Normal University arranged cultural tours in Shenyang and Beijing. In Shenyang, students visited the Imperial Palace, Liaoning Paleontological Museum, Zhongjie Street and Taiyuan Street as well as the Shenyang metro. In Beijing, students visited such places of interest as Tiananmen Square, the Forbidden City, the Temple

of Heaven, the Great Wall, the Olympic Park and the Summer Palace, etc. The students also tasted the world-famous traditional Chinese food-Quanjude roast duck of Beijing and Donglaishun hot pot. All the students were fascinated with the profound Chinese culture and beautiful scenes and took a lot of photos as a wonderful memory in China. Many participating students returned even more committed to their study of Chinese and plan to apply for scholarships for further study in China.

2016 Workshop for Chinese Language Teachers from the Countries along the "21st **Century Maritime Silk Road"**

Three local Chinese language teachers in Jordan were recommended by TAG-CI to the Chinese Embassy in Jordan to participate in this program. They were accepted to the workshop for the Chinese Language Teachers from the Countries along the "21st Century" Maritime Silk Road", which took place from July 11 to July 30, 2016, sponsored by the Ministry of Commerce of China and hosted by SNU. The teachers gained knowledge of Chinese language, Chinese language teaching methodology and participated in cultural tour visits in Liaoning province and Shangdong province. As a result of the workshop, they have mastered new Chinese language teaching skills and cultural knowledge and are able to better apply them to Chinese language teaching in Jordan for the benefit of students learning Chinese.

Summer Camp in China 2016

TAG-CI organized a "Summer Camp to China", which consists of 22 participants from July 18 to July 31, 2016, participants ages were from 15 to 30. Shenyang Normal University Hosted the Summer Camp. The campers had intensive courses in Chinese language and Culture and visited Shenyang and Beijing cities and visited all attractive sites.

Educators Delegation to China 2016

TAG-CI organized "Educators Delegation to China" from August 1 to August 14, 2016 hosted by Shenyang Normal University consisting of five principals of Jordanian schools and one group leader. The delegates attended lectures and engaged in discussion with Chinese educators and took part in cultural visits in Shenyang and Beijing. The program was a good opportunity for the delegates to visit China and gain knowledge about its language, culture, educational and tourism.

Annual Board Meeting of TAG-CI

TAG-CI board meeting is held annually in Shenyang China and Amman, Jordan, in turn to discuss the work report of the previous year and the development plan for the next year.

The International Arab Society of Certified Accountants (IASCA)

1. The Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan Adopts and Applies the IPSAS

The Jordanian Council of Ministers represented by the Jordanian Ministry of finance had decided to adopt and apply the International Public Sector Accounting Standards during its session on Sunday 2/11/2014 under Article (4) of the Jordanian Accountancy Profession Law No. 73 of 2 003.

To achieve the IASCA objective of disseminating accounting standards and enhancing transparency and control over the financial statements in the public sector, the Society has exerted extensive efforts throughout the past two years to hold several activities, courses and seminars introducing international accounting standards in the public sector.

2. Talal Abu-Ghazaleh- IASCA Chairman, the first Arab to be on the boards of directors of the International Federation of Accountants and International Accounting Standards Committee and the Management Committee of International Auditing **Practices Committee**

Abu-Ghazaleh is proud that he had the opportunity to be elected as the first Arab on the world's most important board of the profession, the International Federation of Certified Public Accountants and the International Federation of Accounting Standers, which formulate international accounting standards. He has also contributed to and led the formation of auditing standards for the International Committee for the UN Experts' International Qualification Committee to develop a system for professional certification worldwide.

3. IACPA, the only professional certification has several recognitions around the Arab **Countries to practice Auditing profession**

The International Arab Certified Public Accountant (IACPA) created by IASCA, is the only professional certificate which has several recognitions around the Arab world including in the United Arab Emirates, Qatar, Sudan, Syria, Yemen and Oman.

4. IASCA was officially assigned by the IFRS Foundation, IFAC and Wiley to translate the International Accounting Standards, International Financial Reporting Standards, the International Standards for Auditing, Assurance and Professional Code of Ethics as well as the International Public Sector Accounting Standards

IASCA has been accredited by the above mentioned organizations as the only Arab institution to translate all their publications and to periodically disseminate them worldwide. In addition, IASCA took part in developing the standards on performance control for accountants and members of the professional societies and organizations that are members of the IFAC, in order to ensure good performance and full compliance with the related international standards and practices.

IASCA also keeps pace with economic events, and develops and publishes new financial and business concepts and ideas in order to provide its members and associates with the ability and means to follow the latest developments and innovations in their fields and to excel in the professions of accounting and auditing.

e-AGE was established to be the launching pad for R&E connectivity and cooperation. It brings together the stakeholders and the region's foremost innovators, leaders, scientists, and businesses to discuss and debate new models of innovation, integration of R&E networks, policies for sustainable development in education, means of knowledge sharing and dissemination, capacity building programs, and region-wide e- infrastructure deployment to tackle today's crises in climate change, global economy, food, water scarcity, alternative energy, and environmental issues. The e-Infrastructures are evolving in the Arab region at both national and regional levels as more than 15 Arab countries now have NREN in place or are starting their NREN.

1.1 International platform on integrating Arab e-Infrastructure in a Global **Environment (e-AGE) 2016**

The 6th International Platform on Integrating Arab e-Infrastructure in a Global Environment, e-AGE 2016, took place at the American University of Beirut (AUB) from December 1st – 2nd 2016, under the patronage of the Lebanese minister of telecommunications. In e-AGE 2016, in addition to our focus on connectivity, we paid more attention to users, applications, services and inclusion of stakeholders in research, education, and related services, to facilitate collaboration to encourage resources and knowledge sharing. To that effect we have facilitated discussions, panels, meetings and workshops presenting and exchanging experiences in research and education as well as innovations. Access to resources, services and applications was another area of focus during the conference. In short words, e-AGE 2016 came with "Ubiquity and Cohesiveness of e-Infrastructures" as the main theme of the conference and all activities have been focused on it.

Moreover, special sessions were dedicated to specific domains, mainly focusing on experiences in connectivity and e-Infrastructure, applications and services across a variety of scientific domains. It was also important to show how research infrastructure creates tangible benefits to communities and enables collaborations between them. Different discussions were stimulated during e-AGE 2016 to drive outcomes and concrete results on practical steps towards developing a regional e-Infrastructure.

1.2 e-AGE 2015

The 5th International Platform on Integrating Arab e-infrastructure in a Global Environment, e-AGE 2015, took place in Casablanca from December 7th-8th, 2015 under the high patronage of his majesty King Mohammed VI of Morocco. e-AGE 2015 came focused on "Revealing and Harvesting Knowledge" as the main theme of the conference and all activities will be centered on it. It was attended by more than 120 academics, network professionals, researchers, scientists, and high -level decision-makers from governments, enterprises, NGOs, embassies, academia, and civil society. The e-AGE Platform became a very important venue for networking among experts and scientists from all over the world.

Representatives from many countries participated in e-AGE meetings including Algeria, Australia, Bahrain, Belgium, Brazil, Brussels, Canada, Chile, China, Cyprus, Egypt, Ethiopia, France, Germany, Ghana, Greece, Iraq, Ireland, Italy, India, Jordan, Lebanon, Libya, Malawi, Malaysia, Morocco, Netherlands, Oman, Palestine, Poland, Qatar, Saudi Arabia, Singapore, Somalia, South Korea, Spain, Sudan, Sweden, Switzerland, Tunisia, Turkey, the UAE, the UK, the USA and Yemen.

1.3 e-AGE 2014

The 4th International Platform on Integrating Arab e-infrastructure in a Global Environment, e-AGE 2014, took place in Muscat from December 10th – 11th 2014 under the Patronage of His Highness Sayyid Taimur Bin As'ad Al Said, The Research Council, Oman. The main theme of e-AGE 2014 was "Intercontinental Connectivity of the Pan Arab Network". ASREN started concrete steps towards interconnecting researchers and academics across the Arab states by launching its first Point of Presence (PoP) at London Telecity and working with its partners on new Point of Presence in the UAE, Egypt and the Maghreb region. ASREN is also supporting the development of National research and education networks (NRENs) in some Arab countries. ASREN gave special attention and more focus on users and how the e-Infrastructure can support their needs in terms of services and applications.

More sessions were dedicated to facilitate users with presenting their research and education activities and to identify how these users can be better served by NRENs. Moreover, special sessions were dedicated to specific domains, mainly focusing on experiences in connectivity and e-Infrastructure, applications and services in a variety of scientific domains, and case studies with impact indicators and measures. The sessions also showed how research infrastructure has created benefits for communities and promoted collaboration. It is still critical to show how research connectivity can promote collaboration and innovation. Different discussions were stimulated during the conference to drive outcomes and concrete results on practical steps towards developing a regional e-Infrastructure.

It is worth mentioning that e-AGE 2014 has proudly witnessed the first huge gathering of the Arab National Research and Education Networks.

1.4 e-AGE 2013

After 2 years of success in bringing together a wide range of high level participants from many countries around the world, e-AGE 2013 was planned on the basis of three main themes: Connect ---> Access ----> Innovate. e-AGE 2013 was held under the

Patronage of His Excellency Moncef Ben Salem, Minister of Higher Education and Scientific research of Tunisia and hosted by The Computing Center Al Khwarizmi (CCK). e-AGE 2013 spanned the week of 9th – 13th December 2013 with events and workshops on a variety of topics.

In addition to this, e-AGE 2013 witnessed the signature of a MoU between the Ministry of Higher Education and Scientific Research of Iraq and ASREN. ASREN also announced the operation of its first PoP at London Telicity.

1.5 e-AGE 2012

The 2nd International Platform on Integrating Arab e-infrastructure in a Global Environment, e-AGE 2012, took place in Dubai during December 12th – 13th 2012 under the patronage of his excellency Nahyan Mubarak Al Nahyan, the UAE Minister of Higher education and Scientific Research. e-AGE 2012 was attended by academics, network professionals, researchers, scientists, and high level decision makers from governments, enterprises, NGOs, academia, and civil society.

Representatives from the following countries participated in e-AGE 2012 meetings: Afghanistan, Algeria, Bahrain, Belgium, Belgium, Cameroon, China, Cyprus, Czech Republic, Dominican Republic, Egypt, Germany, Ghana, Greece, India, Italy, Ivory Coast, Jordan, Lebanon, Malawi, Morocco, Nigeria, Oman, Palestine, Qatar, Rwanda, Saudi Arabia, Somalia, Spain, Sudan, Switzerland, The Netherlands, Tunisia, United Arab Emirates, United Kingdom, United States of America, Yemen and Zimbabwe.

1.6 e-AGE 2011

The first International Platform on Integrating Arab e-infrastructure in a Global Environment, e-AGE 2011, took place in Amman during December 12th – 14th 2011 under the patronage of his majesty king Abdullah II. It was attended by more than 200 high level representatives, including ministers, policy makers, academics, network professionals, researchers, scientists, and government officials from 30 different countries.

Participants emphasized that Arab countries face scientific, knowledge, and cultural challenges and that Arab youth, representing experts, specialists and researchers, are knowledge creators towards innovation and development. They also found that e-infrastructures support the development of knowledge through access to resources, computing facilities and services.

1.7 ASREN Launch 2010

ASREN was officially launched under the patronage of HE Mr. Amre Moussa, the Secretary General of the League of the Arab States in Cairo from December 8th – 9th 2010.

Many Arab countries and organizations signed statements of support to join ASREN with the intention to support the developments of ASREN.

Positive signs were perceived about the financing of EUMEDCONNECT3.

High level participation from the private sector was also an excellent sign, indicating that there will be good opportunities for partnership with the private sector and researchers.

2. AROQA's Annual Conferences

The importance of AROQA annual conferences arise from our sense of responsibility towards the future of education in the Arab world. Such a future requires us to raise the level of awareness among Arab educational institutions on the importance of accreditation and quality assurance, and to work together towards building and enhancing the Pan-Arab educational systems and structures.

The annual AROQA conference aims to discuss Arab and international cooperation efforts to improve quality of education, meet challenges facing the implementation of quality assurance systems in education, discuss approaches available to overcome these challenges, and to expand active participation and cooperation between Arab accreditation bodies. The conference is also a place, where researchers and specialists meet to discuss the themes of the conference, exchange experiences and come up with recommendations and decisions for enhancing region-wide quality status and promoting innovative research.

It included several activities such as a workshop focused on ensuring congruence between internal and external quality assurance, the

launch of the Association of Arab Digital Universities, as well as the annual General Assembly Meeting.

2.4 Fifth Annual Conference 2013

The 5th Annual Conference 2013, entitled "Implementing Quality Systems Using Innovative Technological Methods", was inaugurated under the patronage of the Minister of Higher Education and Scientific Research and the presidency of Dr. Talal Abu-Ghazaleh, in Tunis in conjunction with e-AGE 2013 (organized by ASREN), with the participation of League of Arab States, World Bank, academics and experts, researchers and representatives of specialized international bodies. 2.6 Third Annual Conference 2011

The 3rd Annual Conference 2011, entitled "Towards Harnessing the Quality in Education and Research: Challenges and Opportunities", was inaugurated under the patronage of its chair HE Dr. Talal Abu-Ghazaleh at the University of Wales in the UK. Representatives from over sixteen Arab countries, seven European institutions, and major educational institutions in the United States attended it. Approximately seventyfive research papers were submitted, of which seventeen were selected after rigorous reviews and were published in the Proceedings of AROQA 3rd Annual Conference. The Conference focused on standards and guidelines for quality assurance and accreditation in education; challenges and opportunities of quality assurances systems and frameworks; best-practices, implementation strategies and policies of quality assurance in education; quality management systems with ICT tools; national networks promoting quality assurance and accreditation standards; as well as program design and curricula methodologies emphasizing student-centric learning outcomes, modes of delivery and pedagogical models.

2.7 Second Annual Conference 2010

The 2nd Annual Conference 2010, entitled "New Trends in Business Education", was held in Kuwait under the patronage of her Excellency Dr. Moudhi Al-Humoud, Kuwaiti Minister of Education and Higher Education. It was organized in collaboration with the College of Business Administration at Kuwait University, E-City for King Hamad Bin Isa Al Khalifa, TAG-Org, Hala February Festival 2010, Kuwait Association for Human Resource Development (Ertegaa), and the Arab Society of Faculties of Business Administration.

The conference gave participants, including academics and business leaders, the opportunity to contribute to guiding and formulating future developments for business education in the Arab world.






