AMMAN – Talal Abu-Ghazaleh Global (TAG.Global) launched an integrated system of ‘paper documents’ electronic archiving’ as well as of controlling the internal processes and procedures of institutions and enterprises.

The program, specifically established for the use of the E-archiving Department, was developed by the TAG.Global E-Solutions Department to use its own system for the provision of ‘Integrated Solutions of E-archiving and Business Management Process’ service.

AMMAN – HE Dr. Talal Abu-Ghazaleh, founder and chairman of Talal Abu-Ghazaleh Global (TAG.Global), was the guest of honor in the International Forum for Community Entrepreneurship ‘Tajseer’, held virtually to discuss digitalization requirements for transforming leading community projects into successful opportunities.

The Forum was organized by the Regional Network for Social Responsibility (CSR) in the Kingdom of Bahrain, in partnership with the Investment and Technology Promotion Office affiliated with the United Nations Industrial Development Organization (UNIDO) and the Arab International Center for Entrepreneurship & Investment.
