HE Dr. Talal Abu-Ghazaleh patronized the Jordanian National Orchestra Association's (JOrchestra) Al Quds Concert held with the participation of Italian tenor Michele Silvestri, the Russian Soprano Svetlana Kupavina and the singers Natalie Saman and Bisan Kamal and conducted by Maestro Mohammad Sidiq.



The event held at Al-Hussein Cultural Center in Downtown presented a unique medley of famous Opera arias and traditional Arabic songs and witnessed a fantastic duet by Silvestri and Kupavina who performed "Libiamo ne Lieti Calici" by Giuseppe Verdi, and "Nessun Dorma" by Giacomo Puccini, among other famous opera arias, as well as "Time to say Goodbye" by Andrea Bocelli.

The Italian tenor Michele

Silvestri studied music composition at the Giovanni Paisiello Conservatory of Taranto. At the age of 12, he devoted himself to the Opera studies in Milan. He also studied film acting at the Academy Jenny Tamburi in Rome, with the Maestros Vito Palumbo and Andrea Simonetti.

Since 2013, he has became one of the leading tenors in the international opera performance of the musical Belcanto,



produced by Luigi Caiola for Arslab. He has performed in world famous theaters, including the New York City Center, the Théâtre des Variétés, Folies Bergère and the Théâtre du Châtelet in Paris, The National Palace of Culture in Sofia, the State Opera in Burgas, Stara Zagora and in Plovdiv, in the Arenas de Frejus in Nice Meanwhile, Bisan Kamal and Natalie Samaan, the two singers from the National Music Conservatory, performed pieces by the Rahbani Brothers including "Ya Ribou Biladi" and "Zahrat Al Mada'in".
